Epstein-Barr Antibodies

To diagnose recent infection:

- IgM antibodies to capsid antigens (preferred test); by EIA
- Antibodies to early antigens (supportive evidence); by EIA
- Other tests requiring evidence of 4-fold titer rise, acute to convalescent sera:
 - IgG antibodies to capsid antigen
 - Antibodies to nuclear antigen
 - Present in 90% of healthy adults.

To determine past exposure:

- IgG antibodies to nuclear antigen (EBNA); by EIA
- Present in 90% of healthy adults.
